AI for Kids

As part of our commitment to staying innovative and ensuring that children develop skills needed in the global market of the future, we have started introducing them to Artificial Intelligence (AI). At this stage, the focus is on raising awareness and helping children understand how AI already plays a role in their daily lives, with Doodle Learning, an e-learning platform they actively use, serving as a practical and relatable example.

Understanding AI is especially important for children in Ghana, as it opens doors to future opportunities in education, technology, and employment. By becoming familiar with AI at an early age, children gain confidence, digital literacy, and the skills needed to compete and collaborate in an increasingly global and technology-driven world.



Doodle Learning

This year we introduced Doodle Learning (part of Discovery Education) as a new E-learning platform for the children. We selected the DoodleLearning Suite (Maths, Tables, English, Spell) for now, but we are looking to expand this with Science and coding modules in the future.

AI in Doodle Learning makes every child's learning journey unique and fun. Using smart technology, the program adapts exercises to each child's level, offering extra support when needed and new challenges when they're ready. With instant feedback and personalised activities, AI keeps children motivated as they build skills step by step through playful learning.

Thank you to the entire team for making this such a memorable day. A special thank you to Aunty Esther for handing out the goody bags and spreading so much Christmas cheer."




